
# About A God Who Cares For You

### 1. How can we know that there is a God?

PSALM 19:1 The *heavens declare* the glory of God; the *skies proclaim* the work of His hands.

ROMANS 1:19-20 What may be known about God is *plain to them*, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's *invisible qualities* — His eternal power and divine nature — *have been clearly seen*, being *understood from what has been made*, so that men are *without excuse*.

ROMANS 2:15 Gentiles show that the *requirements of the law are written on their hearts*, their *consciences* also *bearing witness*, and their thoughts now *accusing*, now even *defending* them.

PSALM 14:1 The *fool* says in his heart, "*There is no God.*" They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good.

Nature is dynamic proof that there is a God. The conscience, placed in every human by God, also declares that God exists. We call this the natural knowledge of God; it is there for all. The American Indians, the ancient Egyptians, and heathen

### 2. Who is the one true God?

MATTHEW 3:16-17 As soon as *Jesus* was baptized, He went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and He saw the *Spirit of God* descending like a dove and lighting on Him. And a *voice* from heaven said, "This is My Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased."

MATTHEW 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the *Father* and of the *Son* and of the *Holy Spirit*.

DEUTERONOMY 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is *one*.

There is only one true God but there are three distinct and separate Persons [Triune, meaning three ("tri") in one ("unus")]. The Father made us, the Son redeemed us, and the Holy Spirit brings us to saving faith in Christ (The two well known creeds are the Apostles' Creed and the Nicene Creed which are carried on pages 118 to 120).

### 3. What is God like?

JOHN 4:24 God is *spirit*, and His worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.

JOHN 1:18 No one has ever *seen* God.

PSALM 90:1-2 Lord, You have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. *Before* the mountains were born or You brought forth the earth and the world, *from everlasting to everlasting* You are God.

MALACHI 3:6 I the LORD *do not change*.

MATTHEW 19:26 With God *all things are possible*.

Jeremiah 23:24 "Can anyone hide in *secret places* so that *I cannot see*
